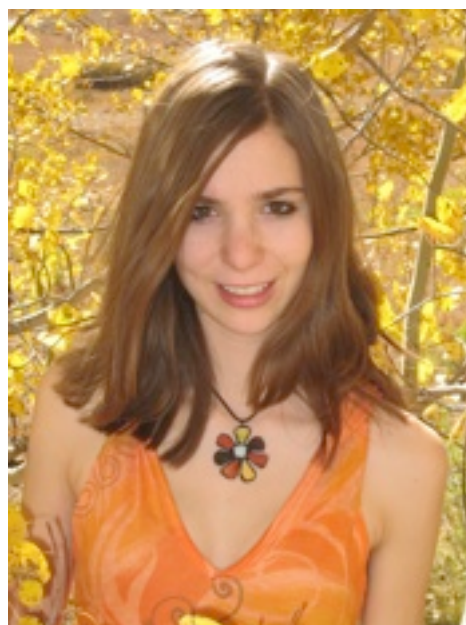


HAPPY HOLIDAYS 2009!
